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Helpful Guidelines for Parents/Caretakers During Remote Home Instruction

Teachers will be available via email and/or the usual classroom communication avenues such as class dojo, google classroom, etc. Communication with the teacher is highly recommended!

Teachers will be available remotely between the hours of 8:15 and 3:15. Please allow 20-30 minutes between responses.

Please read through the plans that are sent home for students and follow the daily timelines set by your child's teacher. Current lessons have been developed for 10 school days however, extensions can be provided if necessary. Lessons have been carefully selected from the curriculum, with the ultimate goal of maintaining a continuity of instruction for students.

If you have any issues with technology or any of the resources provided to you, please reach out to your child's teacher for assistance.

Extra practice and enrichment is encouraged through the use of the online platforms in your child's classroom. (for example: Reflex math, Spelling City, Sumdog, Espark, abcy, Razkids etc.) If you need login information, please ask your child's teacher.

Independent reading is a huge component of our English Language Arts curriculum and is always encouraged.

Examples of other components that can enrich your remote home instruction experience are activities such as daily journaling or authentic learning experiences such as cooking with an adult.

Students are expected to complete the work that has been assigned during remote instructional days. Students in grades 4-6 should be checking in with their teachers daily online.

Communication with your child's teacher is paramount to the success of the remote learning experience! The teachers and school administration are available for anything you need.
