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Technology Device Update September, 2020

Students in Grades 5 and 6:

- Chromebooks will be assigned to all students.
- Students who have indicated a need to sign out a device will take their Chromebook home for virtual classes and bring their Chromebook to school each day they are in-person. Students are responsible to ensure they have a fully charged Chromebook for in-person classes.
- Basic recommendations for traveling with a chromebook:
 - Do not place Chromebook in a backpack and sit with the backpack on.
 - Do not place Chromebooks in a bag with water bottles or any other substances that can cause damage.
 - Chromebooks should be handled carefully to not drop, bump or otherwise damage them.
- Students are responsible to inform the teacher if there is any damage to their Chromebook. Please see technology device agreement.

Students in Grades K-4:

- Students who have indicated a need will be assigned a Chromebook that will be brought home during the 1st week of school.
- Chromebooks should remain at home for the duration of the virtual learning period. Any necessary technology for use in the classroom will be provided at school.
- Please see the technology device agreement for specific responsibilities for the use of school technology.

Fully Virtual Students who have indicated a need will pick up a Chromebook on Wednesday, September 2, 2020.

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Technology Device Agreement

The Frelinghuysen Township Board of Education recognizes as new technologies shift the manner in which information is accessed, communicated, and transferred; these changes will alter the nature of teaching and learning. Access to technology will allow students to explore databases, libraries, Internet sites, and bulletin boards while exchanging information with individuals throughout the world. The Board supports access by students to these information sources but reserves the right to limit in-school use to materials appropriate for educational purposes.

Technology Devices for Home and School Use Terms and Conditions

The Frelinghuysen Township School District and the Parent/Guardian of the student listed below acknowledge and agree that the technology device is owned by the School District and its use is subject to the following terms and conditions. The School District reserves the right to revoke the technology device granted to the student to use if these conditions are not met.

1. The Parent and Student shall be responsible for daily care and maintenance of device including proper transportation and storage of the device.
2. All technology devices shall be used in accordance with the Frelinghuysen Township Board of Education Policy 2361 (Acceptable Use) and any other rules, regulations, and policies as written in our student code of conduct.
3. The technology device may only be used for educational purposes related to school and if used otherwise, the School District reserves the right to suspend or revoke the Student's license to possess and use the device and it will be immediately returned to the School District. Devices may not be used for personal reasons or to download any content not approved by the teacher.
4. The Parent and Student agree to return the technology device on a date determined by the School District. The Parent and Student agree to return the device in the same condition that it was given to the student excluding normal wear and tear. The Parent and Student agree that should they fail to return the device, they will pay the Board the original purchase price of the device.
5. The Parent and Student agree to protect the device from damage, theft, or loss while in their possession, while being transported, and while being used. Any repair/replacement charges associated with damage will be determined by technology professionals employed by the School District and will be the responsibility of the Parent.
