This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The SFA guarantees the payment of such costs and fees to the FSMC.

Total meals are calculated by adding reimbursable meal pattern meals served and meal equivalents. The number of reimbursable meals served to the children shall be determined by actual count. Cash receipts, other than from sales of reimbursable program meals served to the children, shall be divided by \$4.00 to arrive at an equivalent meal count.
